

OUR BEACHES are beautiful! And open to members of the Association, their guests and renters between the hours of 6 am and 10 pm.



Here's how you can do your part to maintain our marvelous asset: Nonalcoholic beverages, snacks and ice cream are permitted on the beach. No glass containers are allowed on the beach. You should remove your garbage as you leave the beach, keeping our beach looking amazing. Smoking is not permitted on our beaches. Use of watercraft, including kayaks, is not permitted inside the swim lines. The amount of space we can use on our beach has become smaller due to higher water levels and items that people are leaving overnight. Please be considerate of your neighbors by leaving space for people to sit and walk.

OUR PONDS define our unique community. To take care



of our ponds ecology we allow no use of watercraft except by permission of the president of the Board of Governors.

Phosphate based fertilizers may not be used near any water bodies. We understand that runoff from roads and lawns contribute to the decline of the health of the pond so there is no parking along the roads adjacent to the pond to protect that environment. There is a small fishing area for families along the concrete wall of the causeway.

PETS are not allowed on our beaches from May 1 through October 1. Our boat launch area is available all year for pets.

People are responsible for the noise and behavior of their animal. Clean up and remove fecal matter dropped from your animal.



PARKING is not permitted on the roads and on association property except when using the clubhouse.

WHILE DRIVING please keep in mind that this



neighborhood has many people, youthful through aging, who enjoy walking and biking on the roadways.

We all need to stay safe so it is imperative that you obey stop signs and observe the 20 mile-per-hour limits. You will not save any amount of time in our tiny neighborhood by going faster, and will put lives at risk.

space is designed for Tennis, Pickleball and Basketball. Please display good etiquette by using clean, respectful language and keeping your voice at a reasonable volume. The courts may be used between 9am to 7pm. Use is limited to tennis, pickleball and basketball and you must wear white soled

shoes to protect our court. Please sign up for play on the SKEDDA platform. OWL paddles or regular paddles with pickleball mufflers may only be used on our courts. There are quiet balls in the box on the court. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

PEACE and QUIET is a part of our way of life. Construction, repair work, lawn mowing, hedge trimming should be limited to 8 am to 6 pm. Monday through Friday, Saturdays 8am to 1 pm and No commercial work Memorial Day, July 4 or Labor Day. Please respect others by not making excessive or offensive noise.



GARBAGE is collected from the brown containers on Wednesday mornings. **RECYCLING** uses the gray container and is collected biweekly. Containers are brought to the curb the night before the collection and removed from the side of the road as soon as possible. **YARD WASTE** can be delivered to the transfer station. Leaves are collected curbside in the fall at street side by the town by contacting the town to request pickup. DO NOT dump yard waste onto any GNIC property, especially invasive plant matter! Visit the town website for details on all sanitation issues.
